Prior to law school, Rameiya earned her Honours Bachelor of Science from the University of Toronto and her Master of Science from McMaster University. During her master's degree, she presented her research at the Pan American Health Organization in Washington, D.C., contributing to work supporting the implementation of the world's first medical hybrid airship to improve access to healthcare for Indigenous communities.
