

Widely recognized as one of the leading trial and appellate lawyers in the country, Tom has also been recognized with various professional honours, including the prestigious Law Society Medal, The Catzman Award, and The Advocates' Society Award for Excellence in Teaching. He is a passionate teacher and mentor to junior lawyers and demonstrates great leadership as the Managing Partner of Lenczner Slaght and within the profession at large.
